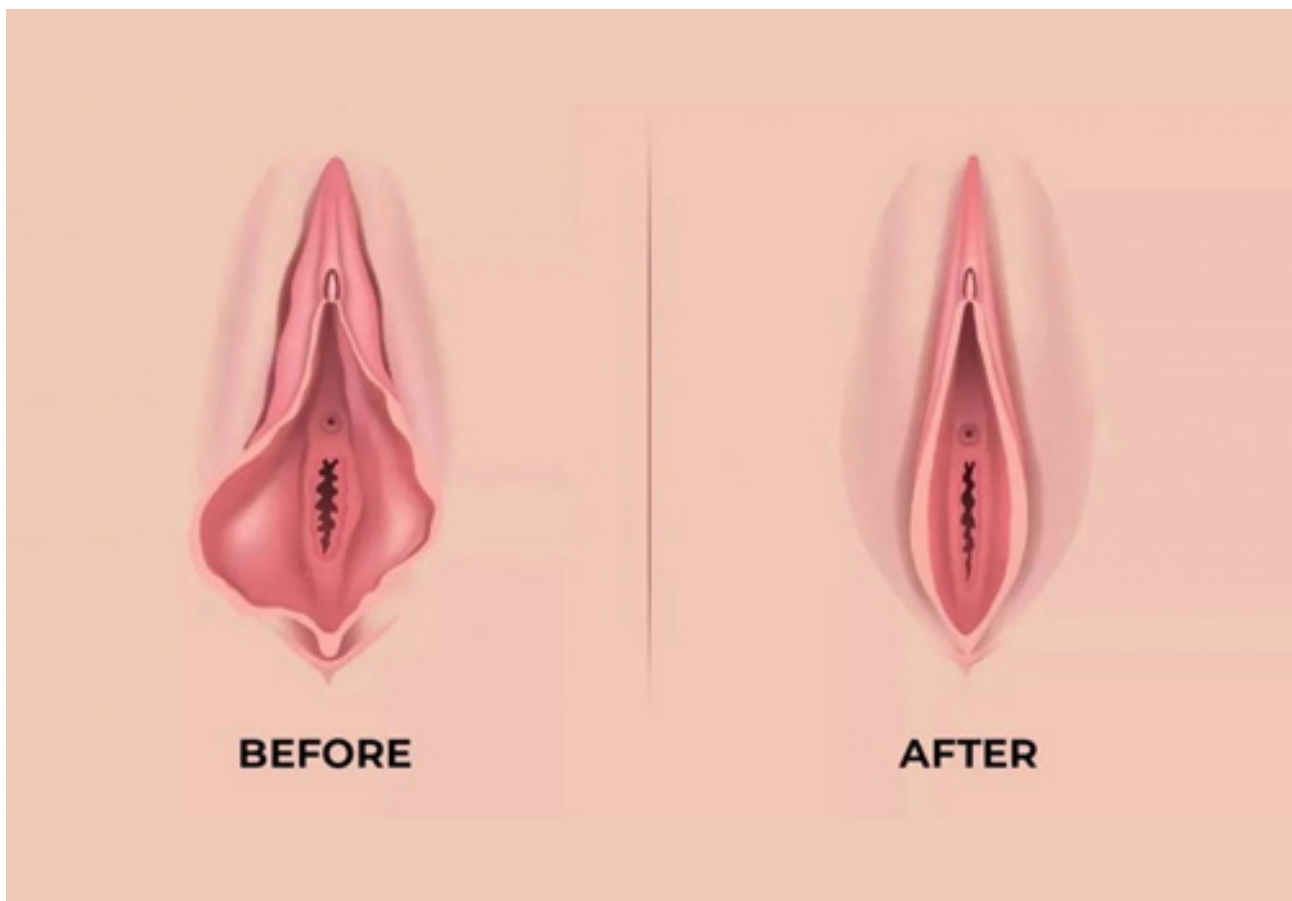
Understanding Labia Fillers – The Non-Surgical Option

The procedure usually takes around 30-60 minutes, with minimal discomfort and no downtime. Results are often visible immediately, with optimal effects developing over the following days as swelling subsides.
